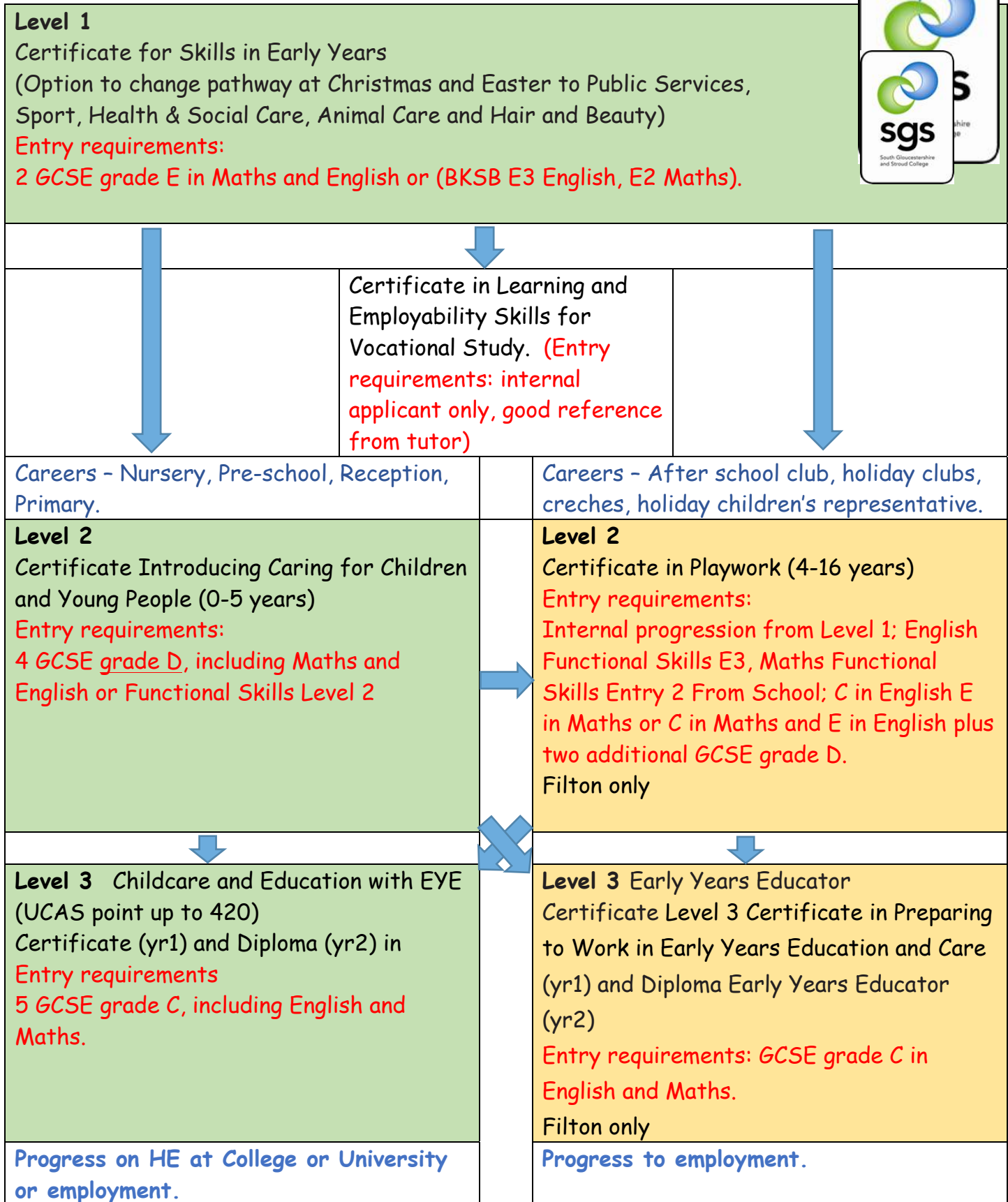

## Level 3 Childcare and Education

# With Early Years Educator (420 UCAS points)

## Purpose

In order to work unsupervised with children you are required to hold the Level 3 qualification to show that you have been trained to the highest of standards, equipping you with the best early years training available. This qualification will provide you with the licence to practice and the status of being an Early Years Educator. This qualifications prepare you to work unsupervised or in a supervisory capacity, with children and their families in a variety of settings, with children from birth to 5 years and gain knowledge of children aged 5 to 7 years.

**Placement:** 750 placement hours across 0 to 7 age range.

**Maths and English:** Maths and English GCSE grade C is an entry requirement. Maths and English will be embedded in the course to continue development.
