The course is built around taught workshops, independent studio/workshop activities, seminars, tutorials and lectures and requires students to engage with research and written work as well as designing and making. Organised visits to galleries, museums, workshops and other cultural sites of local national and international importance will further allow the students to develop points of reference for their developing critical and personal design frameworks.

You will have the option to progress to a 3rd year to top up the Foundation Degree into a full BA (Hons). From this you could then progress onto postgraduate study.

Entry requirements:

All students are required to present a portfolio (digital and paper-based) and attend an interview for entry to the programme. Applicants must apply via UCAS

- Students are expected to have a GCSE grade C pass or equivalent in English
- Points accepted: 160 points required from qualifications with the volume and depth of A level or equivalent.
- Mature students over 21 - Professional/Creative experience profile and evidence of academic ability.
