Summary

Functional Skills are the fundamental skills that you need for your working and personal lives. You can study for the qualifications in practical ways and apply core skills to real-life situations.

On this course, you will brush up your skills and cover topics including working with numbers, understanding fractions, decimals and percentages, working with metric measures and understanding graphs, charts and data.

These courses give you the opportunity to gain a nationally recognised qualification in maths in a welcoming and safe environment. The course requires a commitment of 2 hours per week and you will be expected to attend these weekly lessons where your tutor will set work on an individual or group basis. The course is taught in an environment where learning and self development is key, they tutor is supportive and provides feedback to better your outcome.

How will I learn?

This course can be carried out a number of ways including:

- At Stroud Campus - located in the Centre of Gloucestershire, surrounded by the Cotswold Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The campus is moments away from Stroud train station and easily accessible by bus. (where online students take the assessments and exams)
- At Filton Campus - located in South Gloucestershire which is easily accessible from the city of Bristol by train (Bristol Parkway / Bristol Abbey Wood) and bus.
- These courses are classroom based, with our core delivery lecturers who are happy to help. Alongside this we have an English and Maths Skills Development department

who can provide specific one to one support, advice and guidance pertaining to English and Maths.

Entry Requirements

In order to enrol onto any Adult English & maths course, you will need to come into college and complete an informal assessment. The assessments are not exams - they are used to make sure we offer you the correct level of course, so that you progress successfully and achieve your qualifications. No course offers are made for Adult English & maths before an applicant completes an informal assessment.

Adult learners must be age 19 or over at the start of the course.
