Summary

For these classes the students should have had some experience with Spanish either having taken one of the 15 week courses or have been in a Spanish speaking country for at least 3 months.

On this course you will cover:

Booking a hotel

- Checking in at the hotel, finding a hotel room, booking ahead by phone and making requests

Transport

- Asking about public transport, finding out travel times
- Buying tickets and checking travel details

Shopping

- Asking for opening and closing times, choosing items of clothing
- Asking for different colour and sizes, asking if you can try it on
- Asking for discounts, exchanging items of clothing and describing what you are wearing

Visiting the Doctor

- Asking for an appointment and explaining what your symptoms are
- Following the doctor instructions
- Going to the chemist and following instructions how to take the medicines

- Recognise and explain the different type of weather
- The seasons and what is particular about them
- Recognise the weather forecast on the radio, television or newspaper
