# What do I need to bring with me?

On your first day you must please bring in:

- your GCSE results slips/certificates and any other relevant qualifications you cannot enrol onto your course without these
- pen and paper
- details of an emergency contact including their phone number and email address
- any other certificates or information about your previous studies that you feel will be of use on the day.

#### What do I need to do?

You need to attend on the day and time outlined within your joining instructions email / letter to complete your enrolment onsite with your tutor.

When is my first day in college?

#### How long do I need to be onsite on my enrolment day?

You will be onsite for 2-3 hours.
