1. Pre-enrolment:

- A link will be sent on the Prepared Team over the summer for you to indicate your Academy preferences. Please complete this.
- On Wednesday 23rd August at 19:00 there will be a Live Event on the AS 'Prepared Team' to explain what to expect in the coming weeks. This will explain the enrolment and induction process for you and allow us to wish you luck for GCSE results day.

2. Enrolment

Enrolment for AS students takes place on Friday 25th August and Tuesday 29th August. Please see below for your time slot based on surname.

When you come in to enrol:

- Please bring your GCSE results slip we cannot enrol you without this. If you have this electronically please make sure you bring in the results email.
- Be prepared to have your photograph taken for your college ID card
- You will be asked to sign a number of documents
- You may be asked to sit entry assessments (GCSE level) for Maths and/or Science subjects
- Please make sure you bring a parent or guardian email address with you.
