

A Level – Year Two - Joining Instructions 2023



Welcome back to the A Level Programme!

This letter contains all the information you need to know prior to continuing with us for the coming academic year. Make sure you are also logging on to our 'Prepared Team' where you can ask any questions.

1. Pre-enrolment:

- On Thursday 17th August, you will receive your AS results. Results can be picked up at the Sixth Form from 08:30. To progress onto year two of the A Level programme, you will typically require a minimum of DDD (or equivalent) in your subjects.
- If you have not achieved this, we will need to meet with you to discuss your options and you will need to arrange to speak to us about these prior to enrolment. Please make sure that you are checking your teams messages during this period.
- You will be sent a link over the summer to identify which Academy is your preference. Please make sure you complete this.

2. **Year 2 Enrolment** - You will need to come in to enrol for the second year of the programme during a timeslot based on your surname.

When you come in to enrol:

- Be prepared to have your photograph updated for your college ID card
- You will be asked to sign several documents.
- If you intend to do the EPQ please bring the completed bridging work with you.
- You will need to show you have started the UCAS Apply process; if applying to university.

You should arrive at the Sixth Form building (A Block) at the time allocated according to the first letter of your surname below.
